## **Admission Process**

#### Eligibility

Admissions to our courses are based on <u>first-come-first-serve basis</u>. For the same, the candidates who are currently <u>pursuing</u> or have <u>completed</u> <u>graduation in any</u> <u>stream</u> in the English medium are eligible to apply. Those with PG or other higher degrees, besides the females and the physically handicapped candidates are particularly encouraged to apply. However, a confirmed seat shall be allotted only in the event of its availability for the desired course.

Given the particular nature of job requirements in the sector, the applicants are expected to possess at least the basic skills in reading and writing in plain English language. The onus for ensuring the same shall vest with the candidates themselves.

#### How to Apply

The Registration Form may be downloaded online from our official web portal and printed on an A4 size paper. Alternatively, it may be obtained physically from our Office.

The Filled-up Registration Form will then need to be submitted in the Office along with any required documentary evidence.

#### Fee Payment Structure

Once the registration of a candidate has been completed, he/she will be able to attend the classes for 1 week. After this, the candidate shall be allowed to attend the classes only upon payment of the course fee for the concerned month. Similarly, for all subsequent months, the course fees shall be submitted in advance via any of the prescribed channels by the end of the first week.

After registration, no request for transfer from a higher-level course to a lowerlevel course shall be entertained. However, for transfer from a lower-level course to a higher one, the candidate shall be required to submit the balance amount towards the full fee of the new course opted.




